THE ROLE OF THE LEADERSHIP TEAM

- To be a positive and approachable role model within the club and the community.
- To assist the Instructor with general classing such as: line ups, pair ups, warm ups and stretching.
- To assist the Instructor with supervision whilst the class is being conducted.
- To greet students as they enter the hall. To complement the students' training efforts after class.
- To assist the Instructor in following the club code of conduct. For example, talking during class or running around the hall during class.
- To encourage club students to bow when they enter the hall, start a class or leave the hall or leave during a class.
- To assist the Instructor with inquiries from new and current students.
- To assist the Instructor with formal gradings, Challenge Camps and Taekwondo Demonstrations.

- Learn appropriate assertiveness.
- Learn how to lead a group in an empathic manner.
- Pathway to gaining Level One Coaching Certificate.

- Professional reference stating your leadership skills, management experience and your role within the community.
- Personal mentoring and tutoring with the Instructors team.
- To work towards the possibility of becoming a Club Instructor, Taekwondo Sport Coach and Taekwondo Referees.

HOW DO I BECOME A LEADERSHIP TEAM MEMBER?

- Approach the Master of the school and ask for his recommendation.
- Senior member: Must be 16 years of age or over.
- Junior member: Must be 10 years of age or over.
- Willing to complete Level One Coaching Certificate from ASC (Senior Team Leaders only).
- Willing to be available for 2-3 classes per night per week.
- Minimum grade: Red belt.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- White uniform top with black lapel and black pants.
- Supportive shoes.
- No street clothes to class allowed.
- "Leadership team" badge on right side of uniform top.
- Uniform must always be clean and ironed.
