- To work towards the possibility of becoming the Club's future Instructors, Coaches and Taekwondo Referees.

HOW DO I BECOME A LEADERSHIP TEAM MEMBER?

- Approach the Master of the School and ask for his recommendation.
- Age requirement – Senior member: 16 years or older. Junior member: 10 years or older.
- Willingness to complete Level One Coaching Certificate from ASC.
- Willingness to be available for 2-3 classes per week.
- Minimum Required: Red Belt Three Stripe or above.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- White uniform top with black stripes and black pants. NO street clothes allowed to class.
- "Leadership Team" badge on right-hand side of uniform top.
- Uniform must always be clean and ironed.
